| <p><u>Registration/On -site Check-in</u></p> <p>Umphrey Family Pavilion 5438 Sam Rayburn Parkway Brookland, TX 75931</p> <p><u>Date:</u> Friday, February 17, 2023</p> <p><u>Registration/On -site Check-in Times:</u> 3:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 6:00 p.m. – Registration Closes <i>Check in is mandatory of every team</i></p> <p>Anglers must be off the water by 6:00p.m.</p> | <p><u>Launch/Weigh-In Location:</u></p> <p>Umphrey Family Pavilion 5438 Sam Rayburn Parkway Brookland, TX 75931</p> <p>Saturday, February 18, 2023</p> <p>Take-off will begin at 7:00am. or first safe light thereafter.</p> <p>Weigh-in begins at 3:00pm.</p> | <p><u>Required Safety Equipment</u></p> <p>It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.</p> <p>At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 chest type life jacket worn by each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.</p> <p>Inspection will be held as boats are released during takeoff. Live wells must be empty.</p> |
| <p><u>Fish Limits</u></p> <p>Fish size: 14 inches and over</p> <p>Each Team is allowed to weigh-in a limit of five (5) fish, per day. Culling of a dead fish is not allowed.</p> <p>Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.</p> <p>A 8 ounce penalty will be deducted for each dead Bass presented for weigh-in. Culling of dead bass is prohibited. No dead bass will be eligible for Big Bass awards or prizes</p> | <p><u>Site Hosts</u></p> <p>Jasper County Development District 1861 Beachrock Dr Brookland, TX 75931 Phone: 409.698.2206</p> | <p><u>Boundaries</u></p> <p>The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Sam Rayburn. Contestants may fish anywhere on tournament waters accessible by boat, except areas designated as "off limits", "no boats", "keep out", "restricted" or "no fishing" (or similar language or markings intended to restrict public access) by state or federal officials or within 50 yards of a competitor's boat which was first anchored. See rule #14 for definition of "anchored." That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at Friday night registration. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.</p> |
